

# DID YOU KNOW.....



- Planning for underachieving children is part of the SIP Planning. All SIP committees have to include parents.
- Transition plans are to be in place for incoming and outgoing students – including their parents.
- A Parent Involvement Policy is to be developed at each building in conjunction with parents and distributed to parents.
- The school/parent compact should be developed in conjunction with parents.
- ISAT/PSAE information is to be provided to parents.
- Parents are to be notified if a long-term substitute is not highly qualified.
- Parents are to be notified in a language they understand.
- The reading level of all print materials sent home should be reviewed.
- There needs to be documentation of capacity building activities for building effective parent involvement and community partnerships.
- Parents are to be included in the decision making about the parent aside.
- It is allowable to use LEP \$\$\$\$ for parents.
- There should be an annual meeting for parents for the purpose of explaining Title I.
- Parents must participate in the development of the comprehensive plan.
- Your NNPS Action Team Plan should be integrated into your SIP.
